SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

- 1. Exhibits must not exceed 1200cm x 900cm and paintings may be framed but MUST be wired and ready for exhibition.
- 2. Each exhibit must be the original work of the artist and must not have been exhibited at a previous Red Hill Show.
- 3. Works may be for sale or for exhibition only. Works for exhibition only should be designated NFS on the Entry Form. Works for sale contact details of the person wishing to purchase the work will be passed on to the artist.
- 4. Sculpture can be made of any material and decorated in any way, e.g. paint, mosaic collage etc, and within the theme of "Agriculture on the Mornington Peninsula"
- 5. The following information must be clearly marked on the back of each exhibit artist's name, address, title of work, price (if applicable) and medium. The Exhibit ID ticket (attached to the confirmation email) is to be attached to the front bottom right hand corner of work, visible to the Judges.
- 6. Any damage to, or loss of any exhibit howsoever or whenever occurring, and whether whilst in transit or display or otherwise, shall be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibits will be handled by experienced Stewards, and with care.
- 7. Prizes and Society Sashes will be presented to each winning exhibitor on Show Day. Presentation Time will be 4.30pm. All artists are asked to attend personally to receive their awards. Exhibits can be collected after 5pm on Show Day.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for the removal of their exhibits between 5.00-5.30pm on Saturday 9th March 2024. The Red Hill A&H Society will not be responsible for any unclaimed exhibits. Return by postage will be available at the exhibitor's expense by prior arrangement only.
- 10. A maximum number of 3 entries will be accepted from each artist.
- 11. This Schedule, listed prizes & Sponsors may change at any time without notice.
