SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

1. This is an “Open” Mead show. Accepting from both enthusiast and commercial mead makers.
2. Comprehensive feedback given to all entries.
3. All classes are inclusive of Dry, medium and Sweet.
4. Meads less than 8% abv must be entered in the “Session” category.
5. Entries in the Traditional category must be only made from honey, sugar, yeast and water: tannins (including oak) and sulphite allowed.
6. Entries require 1 bottle: any size. Sparkling meads must be in a safe container. (Crown seals preferred)
7. There is no limit on number of entries from each exhibitor, but no individual mead may be entered in more than one class.
8. Entries will be judged to a standard, not to a place. Gold, Silver and Bronze awards will be given for meads reaching that standard. Judges reserve the right not to award any medals in a class if a standard is not met.
9. Certificates and medals/rosettes, if awarded, will be available for all classes
10. All entered meads remain the property of the Red Hill Agricultural Show committee. All judging decisions are final.
11. This Schedule, Prizes & Sponsors may change at any time without notice
