Exhibits may be posted to the Craft Section, PO Box 69, Red Hill South, 3937, and will be returned, provided return postage is included.

- 1. Exhibits **MUST** be the work of the exhibitor.
- 2. No more than 5 exhibits per person, per class will be accepted, unless indicated otherwise.
- 3. Exhibits cannot be entered in more than one class.
- 4. Care should be taken when completing Entry Form to place exhibits in their correct class. The Head Steward has the right to transfer any exhibit to its correct class if wrongly entered. However, the Head Steward will not be responsible for any exhibit reaching the Judge entered in an incorrect class. If in doubt, please do not hesitate to ask when delivering your exhibit.
- 5. The Head Steward has the right to make separate classes if sufficient numbers of articles of similar types are entered in any class, or to combine classes where there are insufficient exhibits.
- 6. Articles must not have been previously worn or washed. Soiled work will not be accepted.
- 7. Exhibits must have been completed in the last 2 years.
- 8. No exhibit that has been shown at a previous Red Hill Show is eligible for re-entry.
- 9. Exhibit ID tickets will be forwarded via email with confirmation of entries. Please affix ID ticket without the exhibitor name to the front bottom left corner of each exhibit.
- 10. The exhibitors name should not appear on any exhibit. It can be covered up if necessary.
- 11. Official Receipt must be produced as identification when reclaiming exhibits at the conclusion of the show.
- 12. Collection of exhibits is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor
- 13. The Society will take all care, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage, the exhibits being the sole risk of the exhibitor.
