## Amateur/Homemade Wine Regulations -

Ingredients in the wine must be written on a label on the bottle with style and Exhibit ID ticket (emailed with entry confirmation)

Bottles must be 750ml

A possible 20 marks are available in the Homemade Wine Classes (571 - 578) – 3 marks for colour and clarity; 7 marks for bouquet; 10 marks for palate. These are then deemed to be of the following medal standard – Gold Medal 18.5 to 20 marks; Silver Medal 17 to 18.4 marks; Bronze Medal 15.5 to 16.9 marks.

PRIZES - Society Ribbon & Card awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners in classes
